# THE FRUIT OF THE SPIRIT Manifesting the Characteristics of Christ in Our Lives

#### The First in a Series About the Fruit of the Spirit

The Fruit of the Spirit is a phrase found in Galatians 5:22–23. It refers to nine attributes of a Christian's life inspired by the Holy Spirit living within them. These attributes are love, joy, peace, patience (or forebearance), kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. Each of these qualities is important for living a life that is pleasing to God.

When we seek the presence of God with humility and faith, we can experience true joy and peace from living according to God's will. The Fruit of the Spirit is something to strive for daily: a fruitful life in communion with God. "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law" (Galatians 5:22-23).

Paul used "fruit" to help us understand the product of the Holy Spirit who lives inside every believer. The fruit of the Spirit is produced by the Spirit, not by the Christian. The Greek word is singular, showing that "fruit" is a unified whole, not independent characteristics. As we grow, all the characteristics of Christ will be manifested in our lives.

Yet, like physical fruit that needs time to grow, the fruit of the Spirit will not ripen in our lives overnight. Like a successful gardener must battle against weeds to enjoy

the sweet fruit they desire, we must constantly work to rid our lives of the world.

The Holy Spirit gives us the power to reject those old sinful desires. We can say "no" to sin and accept the "way out" God faithfully provides (I Corinthians 10:13) by following the Holy Spirit's leading.

As we give the Spirit more control of our lives, He begins to do in and through us what only He can do – to shape us and grow us to look like Jesus (2 Corinthians 3:17–18).

"See Beyond the Unseen: Protect Your Sight, Check for Glaucoma"



#### National Glacoma Month...

reminds all of us to get regular eye exams and show support for those suffering from this condition. Glaucoma is a disease where pressure builds up and damages the eye's optic nerve. Glaucoma is one of the leading causes of vision loss and blindness. Glaucoma is often called "the sneak thief of sight" because glaucoma has few symptoms or warning signs in its early stages. It can be diagnosed only by a full eye exam by an eye-care practitioner.

#### Some Important Facts You Should Knowing About Glaucoma in Adults:

- More patients than ever are affected: Over 3 million people in the United States have glaucoma, and the number is rising.
- Glaucoma can affect people of all ages: The most common form of glaucoma, Primary Open-Angle Glaucoma, becomes more prevalent with increasing age. However, glaucoma can strike anyone, even infants and children, but it is rare.
- Demographics do play a role: Glaucoma is a leading cause of blindness among African Americans; it's also highly prevalent in Hispanics over the age 65.

#### Glacoma, continued

- Is glaucoma hereditary? The risk of developing Primary Open-Angle Glaucoma is up to nine times more likely if parents or siblings have the disease.
- Hope for future glaucoma patients: Although there is no cure for any form of glaucoma, early diagnosis and treatment help control the disease and slow the process of vision loss or blindness.



National Glaucoma Awareness Month reminds all of us to get regular eye exams. Don't let glaucoma steal your sight! The best way to protect your sight is to get an annual comprehensive eye examination.

# CERVICAL CANCER AWARENESS MONTH Be Proactive About Your Health

Cervical Cancer Awareness Month is observed every January. The aim is to raise awareness of cervical cancer and to promote information about prevention, diagnosis, treatment, survivorship, and cure.



#### Here are some things to know about cervical cancer awareness:



Early detection screening tests can detect cervical cancer at an early stage, when treatment is more effective. The U.S. Preventive Services Task Force recommends that women start getting Pap tests every three years, beginning at age 21.

#### Cervical Cancer Awareness, continued



More than 90% of cervical cancers are caused by the human papillomavirus (HPV). There is a vaccine to prevent HPV infection.




# You can watch these <u>videos</u> at www.cdc.gov to learn about the actions taken by these women:

- Val took steps to prevent cervical cancer by removing precancerous cells that were found during a cervical cancer screening.
- Joy took control of her health by having abnormal cells removed to prevent cervical cancer.
- "If I didn't go to that appointment, I might not be around for my kids," says Cindy. Her cervical cancer screening test found precancerous cells.
- "The routine cervical screenings changed my life," says Jasmine, after a test found precancerous cells

# YOUNG ADULT TAKES TO THE SKY Certified Instrument-Rated Commercial Pilot



#### **SHAMERE TUCKER,**

a first-generation pilot and only pilot in her family, began her journey on February 6, 2023. She received her private pilot's license on August 11, 2023; thus, becoming one of the 1% of Black female pilots in the world and 3.4% of Back pilots in the world.

Shamere continued to study so that one day she could fly worldwide for commercial airlines. She completed flight school and became a certified instrument-rated commercial pilot on September 19, 2024. (A pilot with this certification is qualified to fly an aircraft in a variety of weather conditions and navigate complex airspace using instruments instead of visual references.)
