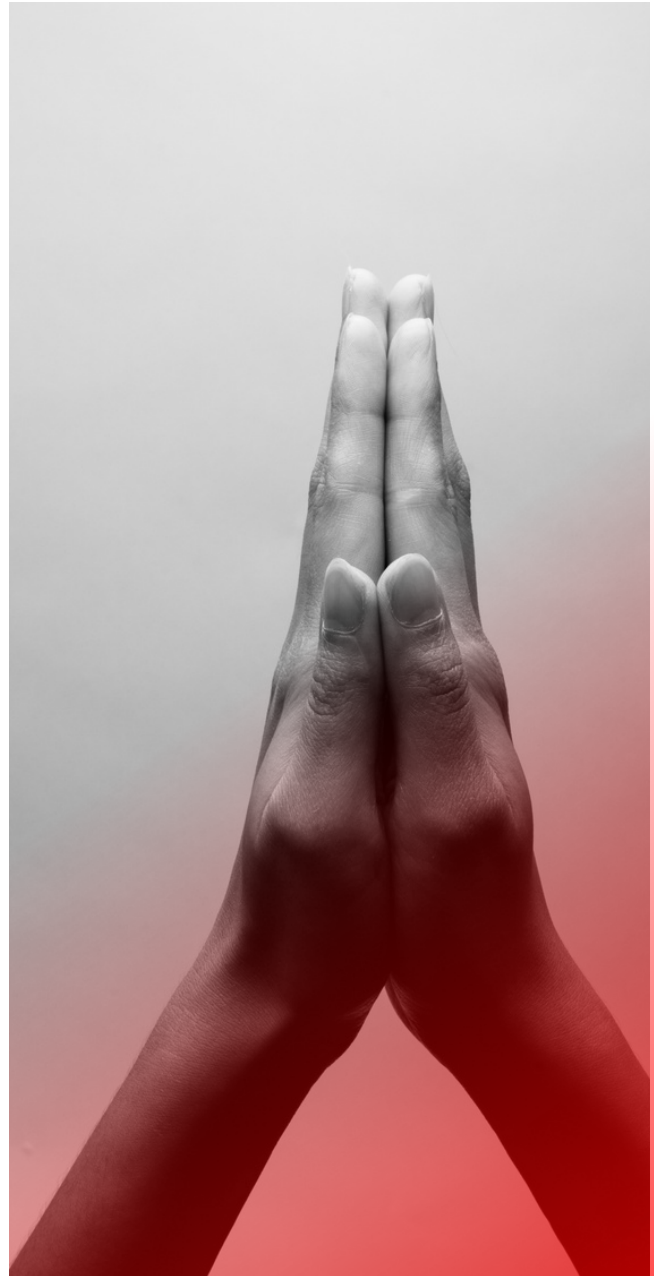
PRAYER OF THE MONTH
