SPIRITUAL GIFTS

Manifestation Gifts

“Just as each one has received a gift, use it to serve one another as good stewards of the varied grace of God.” --1 Peter 4:10

The Biblical Origin and Foundation of Spiritual Gifts

The idea of spiritual gifts, and specifically the "gifts from the Holy Spirit," really comes from the core teachings found in the New Testament. Essentially, these gifts are special abilities that the Holy Spirit gives to believers in Jesus Christ. They're meant to help each person play their unique role within the Church, the body of Christ.

The most significant New Testament event that marks the origin of these gifts is the Day of Pentecost, recorded in Acts 2. This is when the Holy Spirit was poured out on the disciples after Jesus' ascension.

The outpouring of the Spirit was accompanied by miraculous signs, including speaking in tongues, which enabled the disciples to speak in languages they had not previously learned. This event signified the fulfillment of Old Testament prophecies (such as Joel 2:28-29) and Jesus' promises about the coming of the Holy Spirit (John 14:16, 26; 15:26; 16:7) of God's power.

9 Manifestations of the Holy Spirit

- A message of wisdom
- A message of knowledge
- Faith
- Gifts of healing
- Miraculous powers
- Prophecy
- Distinguishing between spirits
- Speaking in different types of tongues
- The interpretation of tongues

These manifestation gifts are how God works through us bringing joy and fruitfulness in every one of our lives.

WISDOM -- has supernatural insight, helping others to understand complex things; the ability to resolve life's problems and sort out difficult situations through the application of biblical truth (Cor 12:8-12).

KNOWLEDGE -- has ability in accumulating information and facts, the ability to understand biblical truth with unusual clarity and insight; has information that can only be revealed by God for the purpose of applying doctrinal truth; a revelation of information for a person, group, or situation that could not have been known by any natural means.

FAITH -- the ability to envision God's purposes and exhibit unusual confidence in His power to carry them out; has supernatural faith given by the Spirit to receive miracles or to believe God for miracles; the kind of wonder-working faith that moves mountains and waits expectantly for results.

HEALING -- the divine enablement to be God's channel to restore people to health, also brings glory to God (Acts 3: 1-9). This is supernatural healing, beyond natural means, given by the Spirit; the many different ways and varieties of degrees in which God manifests healings.

WISDOM -- has supernatural insight, helping others to understand complex things, the ability to resolve life's problems and sort out difficult situations through the application of biblical truth; a revelation of wisdom beyond natural human wisdom that enables a person to know what to do or say.

MIRACLES -- to be enabled by God to perform mighty deeds which witnesses acknowledge to be of supernatural origin. God working through the believer's faith, used to bring glory to the Father in heaven; the demonstration of the power and action of God that goes beyond natural ways.

PROPHECY - the special ability to "receive divine revelations from God to be communicated back to His people"; an anointed proclamation of God through an individual to encourage, exhort or comfort.

DISCERNMENT -- the special ability to distinguish spiritually between good and evil, genuine and false; a person's ability to perceive what type of spirit is in operation in a given situation.

TONGUES -- to speak in a language not previously learned, so unbelievers can hear God's message in their own language or for the body of Christ to be edified; the languages, directed to God, given to the believer by the Holy Spirit but not learned or understood by the speaker.

INTERPRETATION -- to translate the message of someone who has spoken in tongues; the supernatural ability to express the content of what has been spoken in tongues.


