COMMUNION

Christian friends, below are the guidelines we will use to resume our partaking of the Lord's Supper on first Sundays.

Your elements will be available for pickup (using the drive-through method) on Saturday mornings (10:00 to 10:45) before the first Sunday. Members of the Deacon Ministry will be on hand to give you your elements.

If you are not able to do a pickup of your Communion elements, you can use a representation as a substitute for His shed blood and broken body.

At the appropriate time during the Sunday devotional service, the pastor, along with the deacons, will conduct the Communion.



And when he had given thanks, he brake it, and said, Take, eat: this is my body, which is broken for you: this do in remembrance of me. After the same manner also he took the cup, when he had supped, saying, this cup is the new testament in my blood: this do ye, as oft as ye drink it, in remembrance of me.

For as often as ye eat this bread, and drink this cup, ye do shew the Lord's death till he come (1 Cor. 11: 24-26).

TITHES AND OFFERINGS

The Trustees Ministry will be on-site to receive your tithes and offerings on Saturday before the first Sunday and the first Sunday when you pick up your Communion elements; thereafter, the trustees will receive your tithes and offerings on Sundays, from 10:00 a.m. to 10:45 a.m.).
